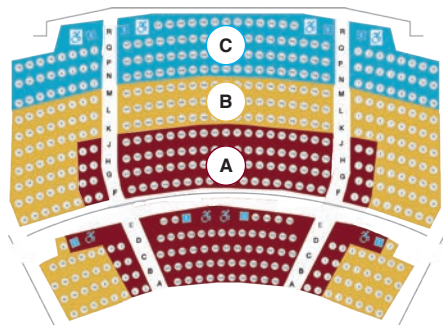

Welcome to Del Valle Fine Arts' 42nd season. We have a lineup of five great concerts! Please note one big change: responding to many audience requests, **our concerts will begin at 7:30 pm.**

Jennifer Kloetzel, founding member of the Cypress Quartet, together with Robert Koenig, will start off the season with a cello/piano recital. The prize-winning Akropolis Quintet, a woodwind group, and the Parker String Quartet, Grammy-winning Harvard artists-in-residence, will follow. In March, pianist Mark Anderson returns to his native Tri-Valley to play for DVFA after having performed in concert halls worldwide. Rounding out the season is the spectacular Ensemble Vivant, pioneer group in the music world and "Canada's Chamber Music Treasure."

This past year was a busy one for our program of educational outreach. Our artists engaged with several hundred students in local elementary and high schools, providing for many students their first exposure to classical music. We are organizing a similar program for this coming season, and we will continue our policy of providing free and reduced-price tickets for students.
